Milton to Impington Cycleway and Winship Road Junction

A consultation note from the Cycle Cambridge Team.

What has happened so far?

We are proposing to build a new foot and cycleway to link Milton with Impington and make improvements to the Winship Road Junction to benefit both cyclists and pedestrians. Provisional plans are being drawn up by our consultants.

What happens next?

A paper is being presented to the County Council's Cabinet on Tuesday 29 September 2009 for scheme approval, and to the South Cambridgeshire Environment and Transport Area Joint Committee (AJC) on Monday, 10 October 2009 for scheme consultation.

Histon and Impington Parish Council, Milton Parish Council, local Councillors, residents and occupiers of business premises in Impington and Milton are being consulted and are welcome to send any comments using the contact details below.

A series of public consultations will be organised in Histon and Milton to find out the views of local residents and businesses. County Council Officers will attend to discuss the schemes and answer questions.

Cycleway proposals (please see plans)

Milton to Impington Cycleway

A 2.5 metre wide shared use path will be built on the west side. It will be necessary to trim back existing hedges and bushes.

Milton: Winship Road junction Improvement

Visibility for cyclists, pedestrians and motorists is quite poor at this junction. Adjustments to the mouth of the junction would effectively narrow it to make the crossing easier for pedestrians and cyclists whilst still allowing longer vehicles to turn in.

Will the construction affect the road traffic?

Temporary traffic lights will be necessary during the construction. It is likely that the road will remain open to traffic at all times. We will inform people nearer the time with the exact details of the traffic management.

Who is involved in the scheme?

Cambridgeshire County Council is managing the schemes from inception through to completion. Cambridgeshire Highways, the joint partnership between Cambridgeshire County Council and Atkins are designing the projects and it is likely that the construction work will be undertaken by Jackson Frameworks. Both schemes are being funded from the Cycling Town Programme.

Other considerations

If the scheme goes ahead it could mean the loss of free bus travel for Milton students attending Impington Village College.
