## Rules and guidelines

- 1) You can enter as many classes as you like. In the photography category there is a maximum of 5 entries per person, with no more than 3 in one class.
- 2) Exhibits need to be grown, created or produced as appropriate by the exhibitor.
- 3) The cost per entry is 50p (except for those in the children's categories, which are free) and you can enter as many different classes as you like. For example, if you are entering a cabbage in class 3 and two photos in class 55, the total cost is £1.50.
- 4) Each class has awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. In addition there is a cup for one entry in each category that the judge feels is "outstanding", and the Cook Cup for the overall winner of the show.
- 5) Please return entry forms to Milton Country Park Visitors' Centre, with the appropriate entry fee, by Saturday 3rd September. Late entries will be accepted only if there's room for them. The exhibits themselves should be brought to Milton Country Park between 9 and 10am on the day of the show. If you are not able to do this, please contact the organisers to make alternative arrangements.
- 6) Exhibits should not have won a prize in another competition (but can have been entered elsewhere).
- 7) Vases, plates etc. need to be provided by the exhibitor.
- 8) Exhibits need to be displayed with a show card which will be provided on the day. Entries shouldn't include the exhibitor's name.
- 9) Where classes in the Vegetables, Fruit, Flowers and Plants and Home produce categories call for more than one item (e.g. 5 tomatoes) the items should be as similar in size and appearance as possible. See "guidance for exhibitors", available on the website or from the organisers, for more tips.

- 1) 5 tomatoes
- 2) 2 courgettes
- 3) 1 cabbage
- 4) 5 potatoes
- 5) 1 leek
- 6) 3 carrots
- 7) 3 onions
- 8) 6 shallots
- 9) 1 squash
- 10) 3 beetroot
- 11) 3 chillies
- 12) 5 runner beans
- 13) Longest runner bean
- 14) Heaviest potato
- 15) Biggest pumpkin (measured around widest part)
- 16) 3 different herbs in water
- 17) Living salad in a container (max. 40cm x 30cm – state size on entry form)
- 18) Ugliest/most misshapen vegetable
- 19) 1 of any vegetable not in schedule

### Fruit

- 20) 3 cooking apples
- 21) 3 dessert apples
- 22) 3 pears
- 23) 6 blackberries
- 24) 6 raspberries
- 25) 3 of any fruit not in schedule

### Flowers and Plants

- 26) 1 rose in a vase
- 27) 3 dahlia stems of the same variety
- 28) A houseplant in a pot
- 29) A cactus in a pot
- 30) Plant(s) grown in an unusual container for overall effect
- 31) Flower arrangement
- 32) A table centerpiece, including a candle

### Home produce

- 33) Jar of jam – single flavour
- 34) Jar of jam – mixed flavours
- 35) Jar of marmalade
- 36) Jar of honey
- 37) Jar of chutney or pickle
- 38) 3 eggs
- 39) Victoria sponge cake
- 40) Ginger cake
- 41) 4 biscuits
- 42) 4 scones
- 43) 4 bread rolls

### Creative food

- 44) 4 decorated cup cakes
- 45) 4 decorated biscuits
- 46) Carved / decorated fruit/vegetables (non-food items can be included for effect)
